Vaccination is open to all approved eligible residents including:

- Healthcare Workers
- Long-term care facility staff and residents
- Residents age 65 and over
- Frontline essential workers, including first responders, teachers, those working in manufacturing, postal employees and grocery
- Residents with high-risk medical conditions, including cancer, chronic kidney disease, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), diabetes, heart conditions, and pregnancy
- Government workers
- Media
- Restaurant Staff
- Construction Workers
- Religious Leaders

The Kankakee County Health Department is grateful for the support of the Illinois National Guard to assist in local vaccination efforts. Through this partnership, additional resources are expected to arrive in Kankakee to increase the number of individuals who can receive the COVID-19 vaccine.
